
TECHNICAL POST CONFERENCE TOURS

FULL DAY THE ROUTE OF THE ANDEAN BAROQUE

DATE: Friday September 14th

This tour will take us along a scenic route with focus on the most prominent examples of what is called the Andean Baroque style. Four churches belonging to the order of the Jesuits will be visited in a one full day tour: The Society of Jesus church in Cusco, San Pedro Apóstol in Andahuaylillas, Saint Jhon the Baptist in Huaro and the Canincunca Chapel in Urcos.



The churches San Pedro Apóstol in Andahuaylillas and Saint Jhon the Baptist in Huaro are included in the Conservation Projects Program of the World Monument Fund in Peru and have undergone substantial retrofitting interventions in the last years.

In addition, the San Pedro Apóstol church is the only church in Peru that has a continuous monitoring system for the structural soundness of the church.

Along the route there will be the opportunity to visit the archaeological Inca site of Tipon.

The Tipón complex is located near <u>Oropesa</u> in the Community of Choquepeda, southeast of Cusco. The upper complex is crossed by the Inca Trail with an irrigation canal. The site was probably used as a laboratory of agricultural products because of the various micro-climates found within the complex. Besides being an archaeological complex, the site is home to one of the largest irrigation works in the terraces, with a great distribution of outdoor water channels that has deserved to be included in the <u>List of Historic Civil Engineering Landmarks</u>.

- Visit to The Society of Jesus church in Cusco Main Square.
- Departure from Cusco in air-conditioned coach.
- Arrival to Tipon and visit the archaeological site.
- Travel to Andahuaylillas, technical visit and explanation of restoration work. Lunch provided.
- Travel to Huaro, technical visit to Saint Jhon the Baptist church and explanation of restoration work.
- Travel to Urcos, technical visit to Canincunca Chapel and explanation of structural problems.
- Return to Cusco.
